Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, the student must meet the following criteria:

- Student must be a senior at Gordon-Rushville High School.
- Student must plan and be enrolled to attend a college, university or technical institute this fall.
- Student must maintain a 3.0 or higher Grade Point Average.

Application Process

Complete the attached application and provide the following information on separate pages.

- Provide a copy of your high school transcript.
- Provide a resume of your high school career and employment experience. Please include awards, recognitions, activities, leadership positions, community involvement, and work history.
- Provide answers to the following questions. Please limit each answer to one to two paragraphs and include your name and high school at the top of each page.
 - 1. In what subject do you excel and to what factors do you attribute your success in this area?
 - 2. What are you short and long term goals? List your objectives to accomplishing these goals.
 - 3. Describe/identify something in your community that has influenced you in a positive way. What effect did this have on the short or long term goals that you have established?
 - 4. What leadership roles have you experienced during the past year? How did you become a leader in this area?

The applications will be screened by the Bank Committee and six applicants will be required to interview with a scholarship panel set up by the bank.
